



# SPECIFICATIONS FOR PLOT MAINTENANCE OF STATE VACANT PROPERTY

### 1. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

### 2. SCOPE OF SERVICE (HALF OF THE NDPW PROPERTY)

- 2.1 Tractor cutting of grasses and clearing of site on open state property.
- 2.2 Cutting down bushes or alien trees to ground level and apply stump treatment.

- 2.3 All boundaries / edges must be neatly trimmed.
- 2.4 Apply herbicide spraying on hard surfaces (if necessary).
- 2.5 All vegetative cuttings, garden waste materials must be removed from site immediately.
- 2.6 Site briefing (none compulsory) on 2023/03/\_/5 at 10:30 on C/o Avocet Street & Gull Road, Southfield.

### 3. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 3.1 The Contractor shall provide all materials, labour and equipment deemed necessary
- 3.2 Staff must be overseen at all times by a supervisor with suitable Horticultural knowledge. Staff may not enter any area which is not clearly work-related.
- 3.3 Service providers should note that service offered must be in strict conformity with the relevant specifications.
- Any quotation submitted shall remain valid, irrevocable and open for acceptance by the Department for a period of 30 days from the closing date.

### 4. OBSERVANCE OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS

- 4.1 The service provider shall secure all permits and licenses imposed by law and ordinance, pay all charges and fees, and give all notices necessary and incidental to the due and lawful prosecution of the work regarding the obstruction of streets and driveways, maintaining signals and open passageways, and protecting the same where exposed.
- 4.2 **Hours of Work:** The service provider shall perform the work during weekdays and within operating hours 08:00 till 16:00 unless requested by a Departmental official to deviate.
- 4.3 **Equipment:** The service provider is responsible for providing, maintaining & transporting all necessary equipment in connection with the program of plot clearing described in this Agreement. All other tools and supplies necessary for performing the work required by this Agreement will be provided by the service provider.
- 4.4 **Obstruction of Streets and Right-of-Ways:** The service provider will arrange to keep sidewalks open for traffic whenever possible and will block portions of streets only when deemed necessary to protect private property. Warning signs and barricades shall be furnished and erected by the service provider when warranted. It is the service provider's responsibility to remove all surplus material and debris from streets as work progresses in order that the public will have adequate use of the affected streets.

- The service provider shall have in its employ, or under its control, sufficient qualified and competent personnel to perform work promptly and in accordance 4.5 with a schedule or work program, as approved by the Departmental official.
- The service provider shall employ only such workers as are skilled in the tasks to which they are assigned. Workers shall act appropriately and professionally 4.6 at all times. Offensive language, gestures or actions while in this facility are not acceptable. The Department may require the service provider not to assign any employee the Department deems incompetent, careless, insubordinate, or otherwise objectionable to work on these premises.
