1. INTRODUCTION

The National Department of Public Works provides accommodation to government's Departments and Institutions. It's mandate is governed largely by Government Immovable Asset Management Act of 2007 (GIAMA). The Department further provides strategic leadership to Construction and Property Industries, and co-ordinates the implementation of Expanded Public Works Programmes.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to solicit proposals from potential bidder(s) for the provision of waste paper recycling at;

a) The National Department of Public Works - Durban Regional Office

The service provider will provide the service for a fixed period of 36 months.

This RFP does not constitute an offer to do business with the National Department of Public Works, but merely serves as an invitation to bidder(s) to facilitate a requirements-based decision process.

3. LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK OF THE BID

3.1 Tax Legislation

- 3.1.1 Bidder(s) must be compliant when submitting a proposal to The Department of Public Works and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).
- 3.1.2 It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful bidders be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Services (SARS) to meet the bidder's tax obligations.
- 3.1.3 The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign bidders/individuals who wish to submit bids.

- 8.1 Government supports the spirit of broad based black economic empowerment and recognizes that real empowerment can only be achieved through individuals and businesses conducting themselves in accordance with the Constitution and in an honest, fair, equitable, transparent and legally compliant manner. Against this background the Government condemns any form of fronting.
- 8.2 The Government, in ensuring that Bidders conduct themselves in an honest manner will, as part of the bid evaluation processes, conduct or initiate the necessary enquiries/investigations to determine the accuracy of the representation made in bid documents.
