The Department of Public Works is calling for bids for the supply of Cleaning Material and other related consumables.

2.2 DURATION OF CONTRACT

This is a once off supply and delivery of the required quantity of cleaning material items from date of acceptance of the successful bidder.

2.3 SPECIAL CONDITONS OF CONTRACT






