

Containers/ crates can vary in shape and size. The standard metal container in use is 2.46m (L) \times 1.5m (H) \times 1.04m (W).

Containers can be manufactured from metal, plastic, pipe and wood bundles as well as treated wood. A bundle may consist of treated wood, plastic pipes, Steel rods, square tubing, pipe as well as other awkwardly shaped materials.

The successful tenderer is advised to make use of suitable interlinked trucks due to time constraints when loading / off-loading the stipulated cargo.

The amount of containers might vary from voyage to voyage. The unit rate will be fixed for the entire duration of the contract.

The successful tenderer may be requested to assist the Department with Transportation, Cargo Clearance and Loading of Containers containing maintenance material / tools / equipment on any Vessel, at any berth within the Cape Town Harbor area and / or Flight, from Cape Town International Airport, destined for SANAE Island for an emergency voyage.

The successful tenderer should also note that at times DPW works on an emergency and may be requested that they undertake cargo clearance and transport within 2-3 days.

The successful tenderer is expected to adhere to the allocated DPW loading/offloading times by DEA.




