## 1. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

AREAS:

1. MIDDLEVLEI /HAWSTON

LOCATIONS: 1.2. MIDDLEVLEI. FARM 566 Portion 2

SERVICES: Creating Firebreak.

Once Off Service.

## 2. SCOPE OF SERVICE

## 2.1. Middlevlei: Farm 566 Portion 2

- Creating the firebreak, of a 50m width by the 2km to be created length on boundary of the resort, Meer & see as will demarcated by the project leader
- Creating the firebreak, of 25m width by the 1,5km to be created length on the side of the entrance road. Of the resort as will be demarcated by the project leader. (25m width x 2) + (1.5km x 2)
- Edges must be neatly trimmed.
- Cut down the alien vegetation and indigenous species to the ground level by hand tool or small machinery.
- Treat all cut surfaces with herbicides
- Remove all waste materials and plants debris immediately from the site.

## 2.5. INSTRUCTIONS

- Please use every precaution when executing the tree works.
- Treat all cut surfaces with appropriate herbicide.
- Remove all waste materials and dead plant debris immediately.

## 3. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 3.1 The Contractor shall provide all materials, labour and equipment deemed necessary
- 3.2 Staff must be overseen at all times by a supervisor with suitable Horticultural knowledge. Staff may not enter any area which is not clearly work-related.
- 3.3 Service providers should note that service offered must be in strict conformity with the relevant specifications.
- 3.4 Any quotation submitted shall remain valid, irrevocable and open for acceptance by the Department for a period of thirty (30) days from the closing date.
- 3.5 NDPW & I horticulture reserves the rights to inspect equipment, machinery and premises of services provider who will be appointed.

## 4. OBSERVANCE OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS

## 4.1 Observance of Laws and Regulations

- 4.1.1 The service provider shall secure all permits and licenses imposed by law and ordinance, pay all charges and fees, and give all notices necessary and incidental to the due and lawful prosecution of the work regarding the obstruction of streets and driveways, maintaining signals and open passageways, and protecting the same where exposed.
- 4.1.1.1 **Hours of Work:** The service provider shall perform the work during weekdays and within operating hours 08:00 till 16:00 unless requested by a Departmental official to deviate.
- 4.1.1.2 Equipment: The service provider is responsible for providing, maintaining & transporting all necessary equipment in connection with the program of plot clearing described in this Agreement. All other tools and supplies necessary for performing the work required by this Agreement will be provided by the service provider.
- 4.1.1.3 **Obstruction of Streets and Right-of-Ways:** The service provider will arrange to keep sidewalks open for traffic whenever possible and will block portions of

streets only when deemed necessary to protect private property. Warning signs and barricades shall be furnished and erected by the service provider when warranted. It is the service provider's responsibility to remove all surplus material and debris from streets as work progresses in order that the public will have adequate use of the affected streets.

- 4.1.1.4 The service provider shall have in its employ, or under its control, sufficient qualified and competent personnel to perform work promptly and in accordance with a schedule or work program, as approved by the Departmental official.
- 4.1.1.5 The service provider shall employ only such workers as are skilled in the tasks to which they are assigned. Workers shall act appropriately and professionally at all times. Offensive language, gestures or actions while in this facility are not acceptable. The Department may require the service provider not to assign any employee the Department deems incompetent, careless, insubordinate, or otherwise objectionable to work on these premises.

## 4.2 SAFETY STANDARDS




