TERMS OF REFERENCE: FOR SOURCING AN EMPLOYEE WELLNESS PROVIDER

Overview and Purpose

The National Department of Public Works and Infrastructure (NDPWI), Cape Town Regional Office is searching for an experienced Employee Wellness service provider to conduct a conflict mediation session and a team alignment session targeted at improving working relations and team performance.

Background of the DPWI Regional Office

The NDPWI is legislatively mandated as the custodian of a significant portion of the National Government's immovable assets. To deliver on this mandate, the Department performs a wide range of activities including the management of a large portfolio of infrastructure projects. The effective management of the projects is complex and requires the deployment of competent officials.

Scope of Work

The service provider shall conduct the following exercises:

- 1. A pre-briefing session with the two conflicting individuals: Officials are prepared for the group/ team alignment session and its objectives.
- 2. A pre-group (32 officials) audit/ emotional impact assessment: Analyse the current team dynamics and identify the sources of conflict and impediments to team performance.
- 3. A group/ team alignment session for a group of 36 officials: Facilitate leadership empowerment and a team-building session to strengthen relationships and improve collaboration within the group.

Post programme deliverables

The service provider shall deliver the following:

- A detailed report from the mediation, group audit, and the group/ teambuilding exercise. The report shall provide a summary of the impact of the exercise and a customised plan with roles and responsibilities to improve working relations and team performance.
- 2. The report must be submitted to the office of the Regional Manager within 07 days after sessions.

Venue and Timelines

A suitable venue will be provided by the Department including catering. The successful service provider shall have access to the individuals and the group before conducting the group/ team alignment session which shall run over 02 days. The targeted period for implementation is March 2024, however dates will be finalised in consultation with the successful service provider.

- A proven record in facilitating Employee Wellness Programmes, conflict mediation, group audit and conducting team building and alignment sessions;
- 2. Affiliation or registration with the Employee Assistance Programme Association (EAPA)
- 3. A dynamic conflict mediator with relevant qualifications;
- 4. Strong communication and facilitation skills;
- 5. A thorough understanding of labour dynamics and working relations:
- 6. Strong project management and report writing skills.

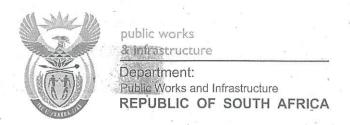
