**Required Treatment:** 

- Dry clean the existing leather on the chairs and bench using suction-assisted cleaning, supplemented with microfiber cloths and soft brushes to ensure a thorough clean.
- Prepare a cleaning solution to effectively remove the white, cloudy film present on the leather surfaces as best as possible.
- Consolidate the leather segments by applying a mixture of Hydroxypropyl cellulose and 2% ethanol, ensuring the leather is reconstituted and revitalized.
- Address areas of missing or shrunk leather by filling with finely processed leather filings, restoring the surface integrity.
- Apply a high-quality leather dressing designed to nourish the leather and protect it from further damage, including combating red rot.
- Identify and source an appropriate material to fill the holes created by acid damage, ensuring seamless repair.
- Mix a pigment to closely match the surrounding leather, ensuring the repair blends naturally with the original material.
- Clean the metal stud heads with a suitable metal cleaner to maintain their appearance and prevent further tarnishing.
- Reapply a specialized leather dressing to nourish and reinforce the leather, preserving its strength and enhancing its longevity.
- Reapply wood polish to maintain the wood's preserved state and enhance its longevity.
