

### 1. INVITATION

1.1 The Department of Public Works and Infrastructure, Cape Town Regional Office intends to appoint a service provider with relevant experience to supply and deliver protective clothing.

### 2. PROJECT DELIVERABLES

### 2.1 Delivery and distribution

- 2.1.1 Orders must be delivered in full as per the quantity and delivery.
- 2.1.2 Deliveries not complying with the Terms of Reference and quantities as per the official purchase order will be returned to the service provider at their own cost.
- 2.1.3 It is expected that all deliveries must be accompanied by an original invoice and a delivery note stating the official purchase order number against which the delivery has been affected.
- 2.1.4 Should the Supplier fail to deliver in the required timeframe; the Department reserve the right to source items from other service providers and recover any difference in cost from the appointed service provider.

### 2.2 Ordering

- 2.2.1 Suppliers must be able to receive and respond to a request for quotation through email within 24 hours during working hours (08:00 15:00, Monday Friday, excluding public holidays).
- 2.2.2 Purchase orders will be placed with Supplier from time to time as and when goods are required.
