1. INVITATION

1.1 The Department of Public Works and Infrastructure, Cape Town Regional Office intends to appoint a service provider with relevant experience to provide the following services.

2. SCOPE OF THE REQUIRED SERVICE

- 2.1 The successful bidder will be expected to supply and deliver the following:
- 2.1.1 Supply, delivery, installation (once off) of automated hand sanitizer units in various buildings and automated hand soap dispensers in bathrooms.
- 2.1.2 Monthly servicing and refilling of automated hand sanitizers.
- 2.1.3 Monthly servicing and refilling of soap dispensers in bathrooms.
- 2.1.4 Supply, delivery (once off), monthly servicing and refilling of free-standing hand sanitizers.
- 2.1.5 Supply 70% alcohol-based hand sanitizer (adherence to Dept. of Health compliance)

3 CONTRACT PERIOD

3.1 The expected duration of the project is for 6 months on a month-to-month basis. This contract is fixed.
