

### 2. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The objective of this bid is to appoint a panel of security service providers for the Western Cape Region ensure the safeguarding of the Department of Public Works & Infrastructure premises situated the Western Cape Region including all assets, personnel and information for 24 hours a day.

### 3. THE PANEL

The panel will consist of all bidders who meet all the requirements and criteria as stipulated in this terms of reference as well as on the PA03 (GS) Notice & Invitation to Bid.



- 5.2 A trust, consortium or joint venture, will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits their B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 5.3 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- 5.4 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 5.5 A person awarded a contract may not sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is sub-contracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
