TERMS OF REFERENCE:

APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER TO DELIVER PROFESSIONAL BUSINESS COACHING PROGRAMME

1. Purpose

The Directorate: Human Resources Development requires the appointment of accredited and credible service provider to deliver Professional Business Coaching Programme.

2. Background

The Department of Public Works and Infrastructure has in line with the National Skills Development Act and Human Resources Development Strategy conducted a training needs analysis for 2026/27 financial year. The Training Calendar was developed using the training needs received from the units as well as the training gaps identified through the Skills Audit exercise.

Professional Business Coaching Programme was identified by one (01) official in the Directorate: EPWP Partnership Support.

3. Expected Outcomes/ Deliverables

This course will equip the official with the ability to integrate theory and practice in development, learning, and reflective processes. The programme supports officials in refining leadership and coaching capabilities, navigating career transitions, and enhancing personal and organisational effectiveness, performance, and growth. It further aims to foster a strong coaching culture that drives transformational leadership within the organisation.

3.1 The course would cover and not limited the following topics:

- International Coaching Federation (ICF) competencies,
- Personal presence,
- Organisation culture,
- Neuroleadership,
- Learning styles,
- Ethics,
- Emotional Social Intelligence.
- Organisational Coaching,
- Integral Gestalt and Narrative Coaching,
- Systems and Business Acumen,
- Psychological Acumen.

4. Total number to be trained

One (01) employee from Head Office is to attend the course.

5. Certification

Learner should be subjected to practical assessment and on completion of the course, should be awarded Certificate of Competence.

6. Training Venue

Training venue should be provided by the appointed service provider and should be around Gauteng.

7. Training Dates

The course should be presented over a period of six (06) days.

8. Specific professional experience

The Service provider should be chosen for their training experience have proven relevant experience in management and facilitation of Professional Business Coaching Programme. The successful bidder must provide a competent facilitator for this skills programme.

9. Special requirements

It is a requirement that all service providers facilitating any type of training must be registered/ accredited with the relevant Education Training Quality Assurance (ETQA) Body or Professional Body/Council and must submit a letter confirming accreditation/decision number.

10. All disbursements must be included within the cost per employees.
