

TERMS OF REFERENCE:

APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER TO DELIVER PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT AND INVESTMENT COURSE

1. Purpose

The Directorate: Human Resources Development requires the appointment of accredited and credible service provider to deliver Property Development Investment course.

2. Background

The Department of Public Works & Infrastructure has in line with the National Skills Development Act and Human Resources Development Strategy conducted a training needs analysis in Head Office for the current financial year to identify the training needs of the Units and developed a Training Plan for implementation of those needs.

Property Development Investment course was identified by one (01) official in the Directorate: Property Portfolio Management (PPM).

3. Expected Outcomes/ Deliverables

The course will help the official to gain a fundamental understanding and practical skills in financing, developing, and overseeing the efficient and effective management of property.

- **4.** The course content should cover the following areas:
 - Module1: An Introduction to Property Development and Investment,
 - Module 2: Identifying Investment Opportunities,
 - Module 3: Property Law and the Legal Environment.
 - Module 4: Property Cash Flow and Investment Analysis,
 - Module 5: The Roles of Property Valuation.
 - Module 6: Property Funding and Financing,
 - Module 7: The Development Process, and
 - Module 8: Property Management.



5. Duration of the course

The course should be presented over a period of eight (08) weeks through online platform.

6. Total number to be trained

One (01) official from Head Office is to attend the course.

7. Certification

The Official should be awarded eight (08) CPD points upon successful completion of the course.

8. Training dates

Training dates shall be determined by the appointed service provider.

9. Specific professional experience

The course facilitator should be chosen for their training experience and have proven relevant experience in management and facilitation of Property Development Investment course. The service provider must provide a competent facilitator for this course.

10. Special Requirements

It is a requirement that all service providers facilitating any type of training be registered/ accredited with the relevant Education Training Quality Assurance (ETQA) Body or Professional Body/Council and must submit a letter confirming accreditation/decision number.
