COVID-19 isn't over.

South Africa's essential workers – **that's YOU!** – are on the frontline.

Add additional protection against COVID-19 by making sure you are up to date with your vaccinations and booster shots. Find out if you're due your next shot by turning over the page.

FAQs:

- **Must my booster be Pfizer or J&J?**
You can get a mixture of the J&J and Pfizer vaccines against COVID-19 in South Africa. If you are 50 or over, your additional booster shot must be Pfizer.
- **Side effects?**
There are usual side effects from a vaccination, but you can relieve them with simple, over-the-counter medication and some rest. Report your side-effects on the MedSafety app (<https://medsafety.sahpra.org.za/>).
- **I've had COVID-19: do I really need a booster?**
Yes – your COVID-19 immunity, whether from an injection or an infection, starts to fade after about six months, so boosters will keep your immune system strong.
- **Where can I get my booster shot?**

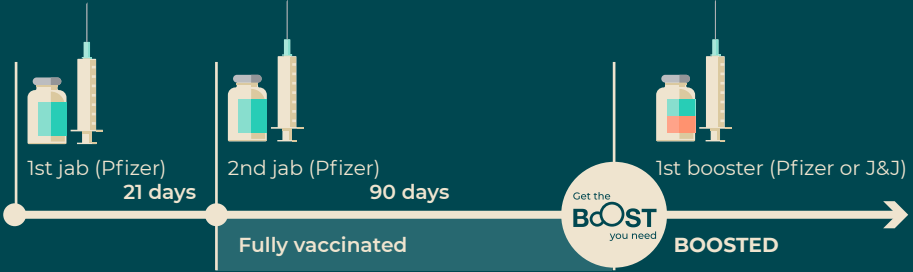

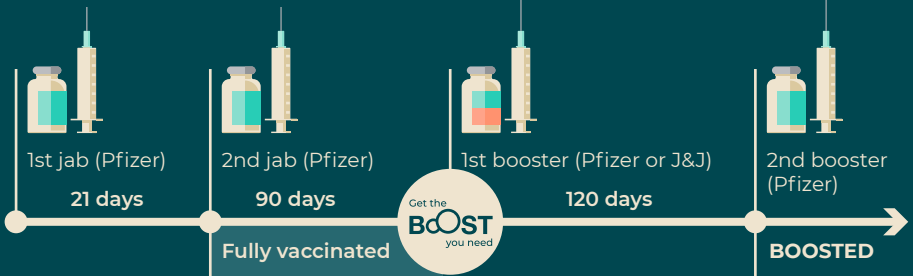
Younger than 50 - Pfizer vaccination schedule



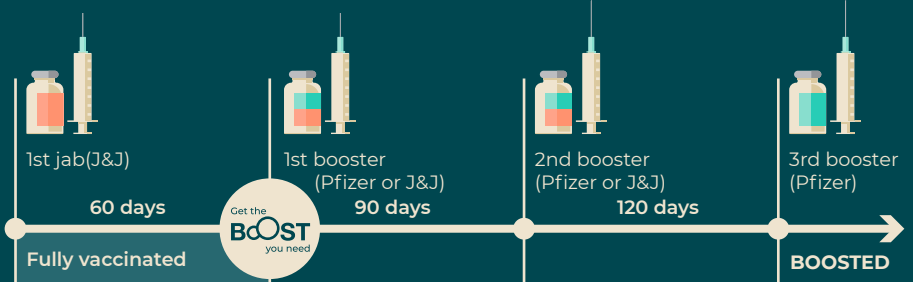
Younger than 50 - J&J vaccination schedule
